

Statement on the WEEE Directive 2012/19/EU on waste electrical and electronic equipment

The WEEE Directive 2012/19/EU aims to prevent waste from electrical and electronic equipment and to reduce such waste through re-use, recycling and other forms of recovery.

PFLITSCH GmbH & Co. KG manufactures **cable glands, accessories and cable routing systems**. These products do **not** fall within the scope of Directive 2012/19/EU on waste electrical and electronic equipment, as they are only a component of another device.

On the other hand, the **battery-powered hydraulic cutting tools** we place on the market are covered by the WEEE Directive.

PFLITSCH GmbH & Co. KG **accepts the obligation to take back** waste appliances covered by WEEE in accordance with §19 ElektroG (Germany's Electrical and Electronic Equipment Act). All PFLITSCH appliances affected by the WEEE are marked accordingly with the crossed-out wheeled bin symbol. PFLITSCH takes back appliances placed on the market within Germany at no cost and ensures **WEEE-compliant disposal and recycling**. The sender shall bear the cost of shipping to PFLITSCH.
