

Statement on the RoHS Directive 2011/65/EU (RoHS II)

The RoHS Directive (Directive on the restriction of the use of certain hazardous substances in electrical and electronic equipment) applicable throughout the EU specifies various chemical substances that may not be used in electrical and electronic equipment.

To our knowledge, no PFLITSCH products contain any substances whose placing on the market is prohibited. Although our products do **not** fall under the scope of the RoHS Directive 2011/65/EU, we nevertheless ensure that our products are compliant with this Directive.

Cable glands and accessories made of brass contain 1.5% to 3.5% lead (CAS No. 7439-92-1). These products are covered by Exemption 6(c) "Copper alloy containing up to 4 % lead by weight" listed in Annex III of the RoHS Directive. Exemption 6(c) will continue to apply to products in categories 1 to 7 and 10 until 21 July 2021.

For products in categories 8, 9 and 11, the exemptions are limited until 21 July 2023 and 21 July 2024, respectively. Appeal proceedings are currently pending before the EU. It is currently not possible to predict the extent to which these deadlines will be extended.
